- Ensure safety is of a paramount importance and venue and equipment are checked before each session and match.
- Ensure E/N safeguarding policy and guidelines are followed at all times.
- Treat all players equally.
- Ensure a trained first aider is available at every training session and match and first aid equipment is regularly checked and replenished.
- Be a positive role model at all times.
- Foster a play for fun and learning attitude with winning just part of that philosophy.
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success.
- Show respect for umpire's decision and impart that attitude for players to replicate.
- Display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with netball including players, opponents, coaches, officials, administrators, parents and spectators.
- Be proactive in continuing their professional development.

I will endeavour to abide by this code of conduct and promote it to others. I understand that if I fail to follow the code, the England Netball, the Regional Association or the County Association may take action against me under the Disciplinary Regulations which may result in Sanctions including fines and suspension.
